

WikiKlips: Using Vodcasts on Wikis for Student Team Lab Reports

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Abstract: The eight minute video shows how students used brief video segments (vodcasts) in their psychology research methods class. Student lab teams modeled their productions on instructor produced vodcasts, using the same technology to produce their own brief vodcasts of the main outcomes and key concepts learned in lab. They shared the vodcasts with classmates through wiki lab reports (WikiKlips). The video concludes with students' evaluations of the impact of the vodcasts on their learning.
